

‘Growing demand for sit-stand desks’

OFFICE workers in the South West are demanding more freedom of movement at work, a survey claims.

Having access to sit-stand desks is a top priority for employees in the region, according to research by ergonomic office furniture firm Posturite, with 60 per cent believing employers should provide them.

Some 63 per cent of those surveyed said having access to a sit-stand desk is just as important as other employee benefits such as a company pension, health insurance or a company car.

And 19 per cent said they would actually turn down a job if it didn't offer a sit-stand desk.

Posturite chief executive Ian Fletcher-Price said: "Having access to a sit-stand desk is now viewed as a top pre-requisite of employment for our country's future business leaders."

It is claimed that sit-stand desks have physical, psychological and increased productivity advantages.
