






Our 2023 donation result

Thank you Michele for your commitment. This #volunteering is an important part of our two year partnership with the Stroke Association charity and additionally we're:


- 1. Making financial donations and donating office equipment

- Helping to raise awareness about the impact of stroke and the need to fund research



Posturite social media content about the Stroke Association was seen 79,300 times in 2023.
























#### Listening and learning






