

Paediatric first aid* (QA level 3 award)

The course is designed in order for delegates to develop the skills necessary to provide effective first aid for children and babies.

Overview

2 day, maximum of 12 delegates per course

Following successful completion of a written and practical assessment, delegates will be issued with a certificate in paediatric first aid, valid for three years.

Outcome

Delegates will attain knowledge and practical competencies needed to deal with emergency situations, chronic or sudden paediatric illness or paediatric injury. This course caters for higher risk environments.

Who should attend?

Anyone who works with babies and prepubescent children in the absence of their parents. Delegates working with children who have reached puberty should hold a valid adult first aid at work certificate.

* This qualification fulfils OFSTEDs first aid requirements for early years teachers, nursery workers and child minders (as defined within statutory Frame Work for Early Years Foundation Stage 2014 and within The Child Care Register Guide).

Content

Day 1:

- Introduction
- Role and responsibilities of paediatric first aider
- Incident and casualty assessment
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and automated external defibrillators (AED)
- Unconscious casualty including recovery position
- Management of seizures
- Choking casualty
- Anaphylaxis
- Shock
- External bleeding and hypovolaemic shock including tourniquets and haemostatic dressings
- Minor injuries
- Written assessment

Day 2:

- Bites and stings
- Eyes, ears and nose conditions
- Fractures, dislocations, sprains and strains
- Head and spinal injuries
- Chronic medical conditions or sudden illness
- Body temperature
- Electric shock
- Burns and scalds
- Poisonous substances
- Written assessment
