

COVID MEASURES FOR ON-SITE TRAINING

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What do I need to run a course at my premises?

Room size:

Your training space should comfortably accommodate the delegates and trainer with social distancing measures in place. Delegates should be seated 1m apart at all times.

Face masks/shields:

Should be worn by both delegates and trainers during any practical elements of the course or when distancing of 1m cannot be maintained.

Ventilation:

Fresh air ventilation or air filtration that will capture COVID-19 particles must be available in the training space. This can be provided via a ventilation fresh air system, or open windows and doors (not fire doors). Recycled air systems without suitable filtration alone are not acceptable.

Sanitisation:

Handwashing facilities should be available near to the training room.

On arrival to the course the trainer will complete a risk assessment to ensure the space meets our requirements. Should they have any issues or questions the trainer will work to resolve these with you. If they feel the course cannot be completed safely, the training will not take place.

What do I need to let my staff know?

Guidance for delegates is provided ahead of every training course explaining what COVID-19 measures are in place and what the delegates can expect to find when attending a Posturite course.

All delegates are to be reminded that they must not attend the course if they have any symptoms of COVID-19 or been advised by government guidance that they should be isolating.
