Why undertake DSE assessments?

- Legal duty
 - Health And Safety At Work Act 1974 – duty of care
 - Display Screen Equipment regulations 1992
 - Risk assessment – office, home, shared workstations
 - Meeting minimum requirements
 - Breaks and changes of activity
 - Training and information

Why undertake DSE assessments?

- Health of employees
 - Prevention / assistance with physical and mental health concerns
 - Reasonable adjustments
- Productivity
 - Pain / distraction free working
 - Efficient working
 - Reduced management time

Workstation assessments

- We know that the working environment has changed
- You will probably have more workstations than ever to have an understanding of
- We have the resources and systems to help you in whatever way you require, wherever!
- Face to face – remote – high levels – less formal workstations check up

Workstation check up service

- Our assessor(s) attend your site and have informal discussions with your employees to make sure they're comfortable at their workstations, and getting the most out of their equipment
- Give dedicated attention to anyone who requests a visit from us in advance (managers can request a visit for team members)
- Identify any risks and offer feedback (e.g. chair is defective, monitor arm is too low)
- Direct staff to internal resources if needed
- Provide a summary of our discussions and findings
